

Salvation in Jesus or in Churchanity?



Many times Jesus told the Pharisees, “Have you never read,” or “It is written.” But they preferred their *traditions* and *positions* over the word of God.

“*Churchanity*,” like the leaders of old, cling to its *traditions* rather than loving the truth of God. It exhibit a *zeal* for God, but such zeal is “not according to knowledge.” (Rom. 10:2)

Modern Christianity is centered largely on *emotion* and love for their *traditions*, which make the word of God of none effect (Mark 7:13). A vast majority of church goers have been deceived into believing that their *physical presence* in worship services and their allegiance to a corporate church organization are all that is necessary for their salvation. The proof is by their reaction, for they will go so far as to say *you* are *disobeying the Scriptures* (yet not stated which ones) if you do not make your physical appearance in worship services and give your allegiance to a corporate church organization. So salvation is not in Jesus alone, but one must also be bound to a religious organization and man-made traditions for salvation to be complete.
